

Pre-event information

Event center

The event center is located at Karepa Youth Camp, http://www.kullo.ee/?cmd=top_menu_glr&glr_id=205&set_page_header=Karepa. Distance from Tallinn 112 km, from Tartu 155 km, from Narva 105 km. For access routes and scheme of the event center see <http://www.rogain.ee/eng/eventcentre.php>

Changes in teams, participation fees

In case of any last minute changes in team composition or if you have not yet paid the participation fee, please approach first the table labeled "Problems. Cash". Changes in teams can be made only in compliance with the competition Instructions.

Number bibs

The team number is the same as the team registration ID. Number bibs must be pinned on a visible place and must be worn during the whole competition (from start to finish) by all members of the team. The color of the number indicates how many members are in the team.

Event materials

Handout of event materials (maps, number bibs, rental SI cards) starts at 8:30. There are several tables, pick the one corresponding to your team number. Send one representative to collect the materials. The map is printed on water and tear-resistant material. Additionally you will receive paper maps for route planning.

Start

Start of the event is from a designated start area in front of the main building of Karepa Youth Camp, see http://www.kullo.ee/zoom_glr.php?img_id=868 Start gates open at 9.10. All members of the team shall enter the start area together. Don't forget to clear your SI-card. Rental SI-cards have been cleared by organizers.

Judges

There are judges on the course to check the remain-together requirement and to observe that teams do not enter into out-of-bounds areas.

Finish

The finish will be located on the same square where the start is. The team can enter the finish gate only in full composition. The finish time is taken in the SI-station 'Finish'. The finish station can be approached only through the finish gate. Rental SI-cards shall be returned at finish.

Catering

Catering is provided from 1 pm. The menu includes soup (both with meat or vegetarian options), pasty, bread, curd snack, fruit drink, tea, coffee.

Prize giving

Prize-giving starts at 18.00. Prizes are granted to the members of the three best teams in each category, except juniors where only the best team is awarded a prize. There are special prizes to the best team with 4 and 5 members. Each participant will get a participation certificate.
